Ms. Pamela Galloway Baggett, 66, of Albany died Saturday July 23, 2016 at her residence.

Born in St. Petersburg, FL, she graduated from St. Petersburg Junior College with a degree in nursing. In 1977, she moved to Albany, Georgia and was a co-founder of River Valley Home Health Agency, which was the first home health agency in Southwest Georgia. Throughout her long career, she also worked at Lee County Health Care and Intrepid Home Health. She was a member of First Presbyterian Church, volunteered at soup kitchens, took special care of her elderly patients and donated to the Salvation Army. In her younger years, she was an avid golfer. Although she was an extremely private person, she was compassionate, devoted and loyal to her friends, family, patients and co-workers.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Ruth and Page Fullington and her beloved brother, Page (P.D.) Fullington.

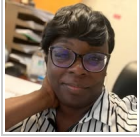
