Pamelia Jordan Mayne, 67, of Leary, died Monday May 4, 2026 at Willson Hospice House. She was surrounded by friends and family.

Pamelia was a proud member of the Daughters of the American Revolution. She was known for caring for homeless animals. It was a great joy for her. Her dog, Gigi and her cats Buck and Lizzie were all strays before she adopted them.

She loved gardening, cooking, spending time with her family, traveling with her

She is survived by her mother Lurene Jordan, her sisters Judith Walton, Donia Harbin, Lu Ann Willis, her husband Tony Mayne, and her daughter Leslie Mayne. She will also be lovingly remembered by many nieces and nephews.
