



## Patricia "Pat" Miller Cannon

Patricia Miller "Pat" Cannon, 88, of Albany, died Saturday, November 12, 2022 at Lee County Health and Rehab.

Her funeral service will be at 2 PM on Friday, November 18, 2022 at the First United Methodist Church with interment to follow at Crown Hill Cemetery. The Rev. Anna Miller will officiate. The family will receive friends at Kimbrell-Stern on Thursday from 6-8 PM.

Mrs. Cannon was born in Sumter City, GA. She was a 1952 graduate of Lee County High School. She was a 1956 graduate of Crawford W. Long Hospital School of Nursing and received her BS degree. She was an active member of the First United Methodist Church where she was a Sunday School teacher and involved with the youth group. Mrs. Cannon worked for many years in the medical practice of Doctors Hollis, Johnson, and Guillebeau which is now Albany Internal Medicine (AIM).
