Patricia "Pat" Culbreth died on February 17, 2024 at the Oaks in Lee County.

The memorial service will be held at 11 AM Wednesday, February 21, 2024 at Porterfield Methodist Church. The Rev. Chuck Knight will officiate. The family will receive friends one hour prior to the service.

Pat was born on March 5, 1935 in Hogansville, GA, the daughter of Richard Scott and Annie Laura Landers Scott. She graduated from Hogansville High School. Pat graduated from Tift College in Forsyth, GA and earned her master's degree from Auburn University.

She began her career in education at St. Genevieve School in Ashville, NC. Pat was employed by the Dougherty County School System for over 30 years. She was a classroom teacher and concluded as the guidance counselor at Merry Acres Middle School. Following her retirement from Dougherty County, she served as a guidance counselor at St. Teresa's School.

Pat was a member of Porterfield Methodist Church for many years. She enjoyed reading, cross stitching, and sewing at their cabin in the Black mountains of North Carolina. She was preceded in death by her husband of 55 years William "Bill" Paulk Culbreth, and her step sister, Jeanette Latham.
