Paul F. Dunn, Sr., 87, of 5002 Radium Springs Rd., died Saturday, January 5, 2008. His funeral service will be TUESDAY 11 AM at Kimbrell-Stern with interment to follow at Crown Hill Cemetery with military honors performed by Walter H. Burt American Legion Post 30. The Rev. David Benton and the Rev. Joe Carr will officiate. Mr. Dunn was born in Scranton, PA to the late Homer and Ida Dunn. He lived most of his life in Albany. He was a veteran of WWII and served in the Air Force. He also served in the Albany National Guard, the Air Force Reserve at Dobbins Air Force Base, and retired after 20 years with the rank of Senior Master Sergeant. He retired from Civil Service from MCLB in Albany. He and Paul Dunn, Jr. opened D & D Kitchen Center in 1975. He worked there many years and retired. Mr. Dunn was a member of First Baptist Church of Putney, and a member of the Wes Causey Sunday School Class. He was a member of the VFW, Walter H. Burt American Legion Post 30, and the NARF. He loved to fish and hunt, and enjoyed camping. Mr. Dunn was preceded in death by his daughter Linda White. He is survived by his loving wife of 41 years Dorothy Harris Dunn; 2 sons: Paul F. Dunn, Jr. and his wife Joan, Kelly P. Dunn, all of Albany; 3 daughters: Linda Gore and her husband Dean, Albany, Peggy Bryan and her husband Tim, Valrico, FL, Virginia Duke and her husband David, Albany; 15 grandchildren; 22 great grandchildren; 4 great-great grandchildren; 4 special friends: Glennelle Fawole, Marry Harris, Verna Walker, Nadine Lawrence.
