



Mr. Paul Wright Laramore

December 30, 1940 - April 18, 2024

Paul Wright Laramore, 83, of Albany died Thursday April 18, 2024 at Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital.

His funeral Mass will be held Monday April 22, 2024 10:00AM at St. Teresa's Catholic Church with interment to follow at Crown Hill Cemetery. Rev. Ray Levraut will be officiating. A wake service will be held Sunday at 6:30PM at Kimbrell-Stern.

A lifelong native of Albany, GA born to Doris Odele Bolton and Albert Wright Laramore Dec 30, 1940. He graduated from Albany High School Class of 1960. Mr. Laramore enlisted in the U.S. Army spending time in Ft. Riley, Kansas and two years in Germany.

In 1965, Paul met and married the love of his life Angie Hendley and they were married 58 years. Paul retired from the U.S. Postal Service in 2006 with 35 years of service. He immediately joined the Ramp Builders with Phoebe and Sowega Council on Aging and has remained faithful 'til death.

His earlier years were working with Boy Scouts, Troop 3. Both sons became Eagle Scouts. Paul was an active member of St. Teresa's Catholic Church since 1964. He was an active member of the Knights of Columbus for 50 years where he was a 4th degree Knight. He was also a member of the American Legion Post 30.

Beside his parents he was preceded in death by a son Todd Laramore in 1986.
