He served in the United States Air Force and the Army. He set up the J.R.O.T.C. program at Dodge County High School in Eastman, GA, and he worked for the United States Treasury Department. Mr. Neese served his Lord Jesus by teaching Sunday School, Training Union and the Christian Men's Fellowship. Mr. Neese was a Deacon and Elder in churches all over the United States in Baptist and Christian churches. He was an Elder Emeritus at First Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) and was a volunteer at Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital in the Emergency Room and at Phoebe Northwest.
