Paul Gerald (Pablo) vonSchlichten, 42, of Albany, died peacefully at his home on Monday, February 4, 2008, following an illness. Paul was born in Albany on February 5, 1965, having multiple birth defects which caused him to be physically handicapped for the rest of his life. He attended St. Teresa's School, Darton College, and Albany State University, where he graduated in 1994 with a bachelor's degree in political science. Despite his disabilities, he was a very congenial person who loved to be among friends and was loved by everyone who knew him. When alone, he spent much time working with his computer. He was also a sports fan and amassed a large collection of sports cards. He was of the Roman Catholic Faith. Paul was preceded in death by a sister: Anna Maria vonSchlichten and a brother: Carl Stephen (Ebo) vonSchlichten. He is survived by his parents: Mr. and Mrs. Harold vonSchlichten, Albany; a brother: Richard vonSchlichten and his wife Karen, Waldorf, Maryland; a sister: Maria Cristina vonSchlichten, Phoenix, Arizona; a special friend and relative Grace vonSchlichten, Jacksonville, Florida, many uncles, aunts, and cousins, as well as many good friends, notably his classmate Reginald Hunter, now of London, England. A rosary service will be held at Kimbrell-Stern at 7 PM on Friday, February 8. His funeral mass will be at St. Teresa's Catholic Church on Saturday, February 9 at 11 AM. The Rev.
