Mr. Phillip Wingate, Sr., 70 of Albany died Tuesday October 24, 2017 at the Willson Hospice House.

His funeral service will be held Saturday 11:00AM at Porterfield Memorial United Methodist Church with interment to follow at Floral Memory Gardens. Rev. Robert Greene will be officiating. The family will receive friends Saturday 10:00AM until funeral hour at the Church Parlor.

Born and raised in Albany, GA, Phillip Wingate graduated from Albany High School in 1966 and attended Albany Junior College. He began work with Southern Bell in 1976, renamed Bell South and now AT&T, and was an employee there until his retirement in 2005. He was a faithful employee, for which he earned an award for excellence in his work field, and a member of CWA, Communication Workers of America and the Bell South Pioneers. He was the director of the RA. Royal Ambassador program at Sherwood Baptist Church and also served on the activities committee. Phillip was an avid sports lover and coached, Dixie League Baseball, YMCA soccer league and assisted in coaching basketball at St. Teresa's School. He was a loving and dedicated father and husband. He was always active in helping his wife Patti with school projects and classroom set up. He attended church at both Porterfield United Methodist Church and Byne Memorial Baptist Church. He was a gifted wood worker and craftsman. Words cannot express the loss felt by his peers and family, he is loved and will be missed. Though he is physically no longer with us, the impact he left on those he met will last lifetimes.
