



Ralph D. Sproul Obituary

October 26, 1933 - January 27, 2007

Ralph D. Sproul, 73, of Albany, died Saturday, January 27, 2007 at HCA Palmyra Medical Centers. His funeral service will be TUESDAY 11 AM at St. Teresa's Catholic Church with interment to follow at Crown Hill Cemetery with full military honors. The Rev. Finbarr Stanton will officiate. A native of Leechburg, PA, Mr. Sproul moved to Albany in 1965 when he was transferred to MCLB Albany. He retired from the Marines after 20 years service and remained in Albany. Mr. Sproul was a member of St. Teresa's Catholic Church, the Knights of Columbus, and the Walter H. Burt American Legion Post 30. He was food director at HCA Palmyra Hospital from 1971-1976, was manager at Potter's Community Center from 1976-1988, was food manager at Ramada Inn from 1988-1992, worked at Buffalo Rock Pepsi from 1992-1998, and worked at the Knights of Columbus from 1998 until his death. He was preceded in death by his parents: Raymond D. and Gladys Wilson Sproul, a brother: Samuel Sproul, and a sister: Edna Faulk. Mr. Sproul is survived by his wife: Bertha Sproul, Albany; 3 sons: Kenneth R. Sproul, Kevin R. Sproul and his wife Vicki, Keith R. Sproul and his wife Bonnie Gail, all of Albany; a daughter: Karen S. Bush and her husband Tony, Rome, GA; 6 grandchildren: Matthew K. Sproul, Amber d. Sproul, Breanne E. Sproul, Jacob R. Sproul, Sydney Bush, Summer "Rocky" Bush; a brother: Raymond D. Sproul, Jr. and his wife Catherine, San Leandro, CA. There will be a prayer service at Kimbrell-Stern Monday (Today) at 7 PM with visitation to follow until 8:30 PM.
