Ray Thomas Tumlin, 85, died Thursday, June 28, 2018 at his residence. Graveside services will be held Monday, July 2, 2018 at 11:00 AM at Floral Memory Gardens. Visitation will be at their residence. Rev. Lee Smith will officiate.

Mr. Tumlin was a Korean War veteran, serving in the US Navy.
