



Raymond T. Gomolski Obituary

September 12, 1915 - February 9, 2009

Mr. Raymond Thadeus Gomolski, 93, of Albany, GA, died February 9, 2009 at Lee County Health Care in Leesburg, GA. Mr. Gomolski was born September 12, 1915, in Toledo, OH to Joseph and Anna Gomolski. He graduated from Libby High School in Toledo, OH and played on the smallest football team that ever played in Toledo. Mr. Gomolski joined the United States Army in 1941. He married the love of his life, Mary Arlen Vaughn, on September 19, 1942. In 1943, he was commissioned into The United States Army and stationed at Turner Field in Albany. After completing his military service, Mr. Gomolski worked for Metropolitan Life Insurance Company, retiring with 21 years of service. He was a longtime member of the American Legion Post 30 in Albany where he served numerous terms on the Executive Committee. Mr. Gomolski was preceded in death by his parents, wife, two sisters, Alice Kadluboski and Irene Wozniak; and one brother, Daniel Gomolski. Survivors include his nephew, James Wozniak, one special cousin Patricia Gomolski, both of Toledo, OH and numerous other cousins, nieces and nephews.
