Ms. Rebecca Q. Bass of Albany died Tuesday April 1, 2014 at Wynfield Park Health and Rehabilitation. A private funeral service will be held at a later date. Becky was born in Doerun, GA (Colquitt County) on May 2, 1928. She moved to Albany as a child. She was a graduate of Albany High School and Georgia Southwestern College in Americus.

Becky was a Secretary and office manager for Borden's Ice Cream Industries for many years, as well as for Aetna Life Insurance Company. Upon her retirement in 1988 from the Albany Herald, where she was office manager in charge of employee benefits, she spent much of her time playing Duplicate and Tournament Bridge. She was an avid bridge player and was on the National Register of Bridge Players as a Life Master.

Becky was preceded in death by her parents Z.F. and Vonnie O. Bass, a brother David Bass, and a nephew Brad Bass.
