Richard Eric Eberhardt, 75, of Albany, died Monday, April 7, 2025.

His memorial service will be on Saturday, April 12, 2025 at 2 PM at Kimbrell-Stern. The family will receive friends on Saturday prior to the service beginning at 1 PM at Kimbrell-Stern.

Mr. Eberhardt was born in Dublin, GA and graduated from Jenkins County High School. He received his undergraduate degree from Georgia Southwestern College and a master's degree from Troy University. He served in the US Marine Corps from 1971-1973. Mr. Eberhardt moved to Albany in 1980. He retired from Miller Brewing after many years of employment. He was a member of First Christian Church of Dublin, was an active member of the Exchange Club of Albany, and enjoyed fishing, golfing, and especially his Georgia Bulldogs.

Rick was a gentleman and a generally good guy. No one ever heard him utter an unkind word to anyone or about anyone. His friends and neighbors knew him to be quiet, patient, and quick to laugh. Although he endured several very serious health and medical challenges during his senior years, he met each one with bravery and hopefulness. He was preceded in death by his parents, William and Wilda Partridge Eberhardt, and a brother, William (Billy) Landrum Eberhardt.

Mr. Eberhardt is survived by his wife of 45 years: Teresa Eberhardt, Albany; proud father of two sons: David Eberhardt and Michael Eberhardt, both of Albany.
