ALBANY – Mr. Richard Lee Morefield (WB4TFW), 85, of Albany, passed away peacefully at his residence, Tuesday, June 28, 2016.

Visitation will be held 6:00pm to 8:00pm, Tuesday, July 5, 2016 at Kimbrel-Stern. A graveside service will be held 10:00am at Crown Hill Cemetery, Veteran's Section.

Born December 10, 1930 in Enid, OK. Mr. Morefield was the son of the late Glenn and Ruby Morefield. Mr. Morefield began a long and eventful military career with the 45th Infantry Oklahoma National Guard where his unit was activated to Federal Service and deployed to Korea during the Korean Conflict. He later enlisted in the United States Navy as a Photographers Mate and retired after 21 years as a Chief Photographers Mate.

His enthusiasm for photography continued after retirement from the US Navy as the manager of the Photo Lab at the Marine Corps Logistics Base, Albany, GA. Where he retired after 21 years.
