Mr. Richard Wayne Weathersby, 76, died Sunday, July 3, 2016 at Wilson Hospice House in Albany, GA. A funeral service will be held in honor of Mr. Weathersby on July 6, 2016 at 2 PM at Kimbrell-Stern. Rev. Ken Chancellor will be officiating. The family will receive friends one hour before the service starting at 1 PM.
