There is not enough space or time to tell all of the things we did with and for each other.

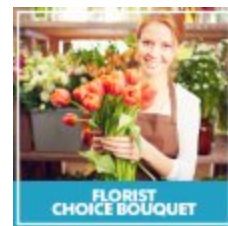
I loved him very much and will miss him greatly. He know has his wings and can fly again. Something that he enjoyed very much.
