Robert (Bob) L. Davis, 89, of Albany, died on Wednesday, April 23, 2008. Mr. Davis was born in Murphy, North Carolina on Christmas Day in 1918. He ranched and played professional baseball in Jerome, Idaho as a young man. He and his wife, Mae, moved to Georgia in 1948 where he farmed and later worked and retired from Pritchett Ford as Service Manager. He was a veteran of the US Navy during World War II.
