



Mr. Robert J."Jack" Fisher

April 26, 1927 - September 10, 2015

Robert J. "Jack" Fisher, 88, of Albany, died Thursday, September 10, 2015 at Evergreen Assisted Living.

His memorial service will be at 2 PM on Sunday, September 13, 2015 at Kimbrell-Stern. Rabbi Dr. Holly Levin Cohn will officiate.

Mr. Fisher was born April 26, 1927 to Rosa Schine Fisher and Isadore Fisher in Sylvester, GA. The family moved to Albany when he was seven months old. They resided on South Monroe St., and later moved to 520 Highland Ave., where he lived with his mother and father and older sister Marjorie. Another sister, Ruth, lived in Savannah and an older brother, Philip, in Augusta, all preceded him in death.

Mr. Fisher attended Albany public schools and upon graduation entered Emory Junior College for one year before transferring to Georgia Institute of Technology as a chemical engineering student. After 2 years he was drafted into military service and received basic training at Ft. Knox, KY. He went overseas, first to Shanghai and then to Seoul. Upon his return to the US, he enrolled at the University Of Georgia School Of Pharmacy. He received his degree in 1950, and became a Licensed Pharmacist in 1951. Mr. Fisher worked as a pharmacist employed by Crowe's Drug and Albany Drug Co. for a total of 43 years. Upon retiring, he worked part-time for several drugstores in

Albany.

Mr. Fisher was a member of Temple B’Nai Israel, Kiwanis Golden K Club, the Albany Amateur Radio Club, and he was a Mason. He enjoyed reading, golf, watercolor painting, people, good humor, and special friendships.

He is survived two nieces: Barbi Fisher and her husband Ted Fralick, Albany, Judy Rutberg-Self, Seattle, WA, three nephews: Carey Fisher and his wife Carol, Duluth, GA, Barry Cooper and his wife Sherry, Lake Wales, FL, Ira Rutberg, Washington, DC; several great-nieces and great-nephews.
