



Robert Newcomb, Jr. Obituary

November 23, 1955 - July 28, 2006

Robert "Robin" Dixon Newcomb Jr., 50 of Leesburg died Friday at Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital following an illness. His remains have been cremated and a casual memorial service will be 10:30 AM Tuesday at St. Paul's Episcopal Church with Rev. Mark Jones officiating. A native of Albany, Robin was a wonderful loving father, husband, brother and friend. He was a 1976 graduate of Albany High School, and a lifetime member of St. Paul's Episcopal Church. He loved all water sports and he earned both a God and Country and Eagle Scout award. He was a former warehouse foreman at Newcomb Inc. and CarQuest Distribution Center. He was preceded in death by a grandson, Dawson Ray Brown. He is survived by 2 daughters: Mindi Newcomb and Katie Newcomb and son, Rob Newcomb III, all of Leesburg, his parents Bob & Mimi Newcomb of Albany, 2 sisters: Bland Cleesattle and her husband Don of Leesburg, Ri Lamb and her husband Don of Albany, a brother Ned Newcomb and his wife Mary of Leesburg; his former wife Terri Rentz Newcomb of Albany and a host of loving nieces and nephews.
