Robert "Bob" Thomas Vaupel, 70, of Albany, died Sunday, September 23, 2007 at Palmyra Medical Center. The funeral service will be held at 3 PM Wednesday at Kimbrell-Stern Funeral Directors with interment to follow in Floral Memory Gardens. The Rev. Fred Bell will officiate. A native of Niles, Ohio, Mr. Vaupel had lived in Albany for 45 years. He served in the United States Marine Corps during the Vietnam and Korean wars. Mr. Vaupel was in the Masonic Lodge # 24, was a 32nd degree Scottish Rite Mason, and was a lifetime member of the VFW. He worked for many years with Air Products, and also with the Dougherty County Sheriff's office.
