Roger Lee Houseman of Leesburg, GA, was born on June 26, 1948, in Ishpeming, MI. He passed away Sunday, October 29, 2023. He was a kind and loving husband, step-father, and grandfather who was always willing to help family and friends.

A 1966 graduate of Neguinee High School in Michigan, Roger lived and worked in Michigan, Oklahoma, Wyoming, Texas (The King Ranch), and Georgia. Aside from his trademark overalls, Roger wore many different hats throughout his life. He was a cowboy, a ranch hand, a horse trainer, a carnie, an oil rig operator, a welder, a trucker, and a caregiver.

Roger's passion for horses brought him to Albany in the early 1990s where he volunteered at Good Life Therapeutic Equestrian Center and helped people with disabilities enjoy horseback riding. While in Albany, Roger worked for Ayers and Roadway. He volunteered with Albany Alzheimer's Association, ACTO, Lions Club, American Heart Association, and the Mattie Marshall Alzheimer's Center in Americus. He truly was a gentle giant who cared for children, the elderly, the disabled, and animals.

Roger loved working on machinery; there wasn't anything he couldn't fix, and his big red truck was always a work in progress. In the evening, he enjoyed watching old westerns on TV, especially Gunsmoke.

Mr. Houseman was preceded in death by his parents, Henry and Hazel Houseman, and his siblings. He is survived by his wife, Connie Littleton Hardison Houseman; his step son, Tom Hardison of Leesburg, GA (Kathy); his grandchildren, Trey Hardison of San Antonio, TX (Ellison) and Angie Hardison of Leesburg; great-grandchildren, Henry and Ellie Kate Hardison of San Antonio; and a host of nieces and nephews and extended family in Michigan.
