



Reverend Ronald L. Davidson Obituary

April 10, 1950 - July 5, 2009

The Reverend Ronald Leon Davidson died unexpectedly on Sunday July 5, 2009. Fr. Davidson was an ordained priest in the Episcopal Church in 1988 and served several churches in the Diocese of Georgia. He served several terms on Diocesan Council and was Spiritual Director for Georgia Cursillos in Christianity for seven years. He is survived by his wife, Elizabeth Mann Davidson; a son, Lee Davidson; a daughter, Diana Pearson; five grandchildren, and a sister, Shelby Huggins of Jacksonville, Texas.
