



## Ronald W. Harris, MD

Ronald W. Harris, MD, a Board Certified Radiologist, of Dawson, Georgia passed away Sunday, December 15, 2024 at the age of 74. at his home after a lengthy illness. A private service was held at Riverside Cemetery, Albany, Georgia.

Dr. Harris was born in Eastman, Georgia and moved to Albany when he was four years old. He graduated from Meharry Medical School in Nashville, Tennessee, and completed his internship at Columbus Medical Center in Columbus, Georgia and fulfilled a residency at LSU and Tulane University in New Orleans, Louisiana. While at LSU, Dr. Harris completed an invasive radiology fellowship.

After his fellowship at LSU, Dr. Harris completed a second fellowship in MRI Radiology at Women's and Children's Hospital, Harvard Medical School in Boston, Massachusetts. Ronald W. Harris M.D. began his radiology practice with Radiology Associates at Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital, Albany, Georgia, and continued practicing as a board certified radiologist many years throughout the state of Georgia. Besides working in the field of medicine, Dr. Harris was an avid outdoorsman since childhood. He developed a passion for fine cooking and became an expert Cajun chef sharing his love of food with his many friends.

Dr. Harris was preceded in death by his parents, Geraldine B. Harris, and Leon W. Harris. Dr. Harris' memory will remain in the hearts of his family, friends, and all those who were honored to have had the privilege of knowing him.
