



## Ronald J. Overstreet Obituary

Ronald Jack Overstreet, of Albany, died September 21, 2007. His funeral service will be 11 AM, Monday September 24, 2007 at Kimbrell-Stern Funeral Directors. Rev. Shawn Cook will officiate. A private interment will follow in Floral Memory Gardens. Mr. Overstreet was born in 1938, to the late Jack Lee Overstreet and Mary Christine Hamblin in Roanoke VA... He resided in Albany for more than 34 years. He served his country as a member of the United States Air Force. He was a Mason, a member of Albany Lodge #24 F. & A.M., and was a member of Bible Baptist Church. He retired from Helena Chemical Co. following 34 years as Warehouse Manager. He was preceded in death by his brother Robert Lee Overstreet. He is survived by 2 daughters: Ronda Zoellick of Covington, and Chrissy Miller of Albany; 2 sons: Thomas Lee Overstreet of Albany, and Sgt. 1st Class Ronald J. Overstreet, Jr., US Army; and his wife Amy; 4 granddaughters: Holly and Ivy Miller, and Tara and Tori Zoellick; a niece Dawn Overstreet Moon and a nephew Mark Overstreet, both of Conyers.
