Born Sarah Rosalie Brown on June 17, 1925, in Norfolk, VA, she was the daughter of the late Bonner and Mary Webb Brown, the wife of former Albany Mayor Eugene R. Clark, Jr., and a widely known and active member of this community for most of her life. Mrs. Clark was a member of the local chapters of the Colonial Dames, the Junior League, the Daughters of the American Revolution, and the Palmyra Heights Garden Club. A communicant of St Paul's Episcopal Church, she served the parish faithfully in a variety of functions, including as Chairman of the Alter Guild, a member of St. Mary's chapter, and a founding
