



## Rosalina "Rose" Gomes Dunlap

December 14, 1927 - March 22, 2024

Rosalina "Rose" Gomes Dunlap, 96, of Albany died March 22, 2024. Her memorial service will be held June 8 at 2pm at St. Patrick's Episcopal Church with a reception to follow.

Rose was born December 14, 1927 in New Bedford, Mass., the 3rd of five children. She married Roy Dunlap in 1948 and they lived in Providence RI until they moved to Albany in 1965 when Roy was transferred with Coats and Clark. 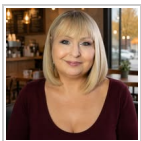
