Roy Douglas (Doug) Oliver, 76, of Albany, died on Monday, December 7, 2015 after an extended illness. He was born in Sylvester, Georgia on December 12, 1938 to John Monroe Oliver, Sr. and Nettie Kilcrease Oliver. He is survived by his wife of 55 years, Alma Oliver. He is also survived by his son, Greg Oliver, and daughter, Kellie Oliver. He has two grandsons, Jansen Oliver and Loren Oliver. He is survived by his siblings, Alouida Murphy (Kenneth), John M. Oliver, Sr., Nettawyl Davis, and Bobbie Hobby as well as many beloved cousins, nieces and nephews.

Mr. Oliver was employed by WALB-TV for thirty years. He worked as President and General Manager of WALB-TV before becoming owner, President and CEO of WFXL-TV in Albany. He was an active participant in the community for many years. A few of his roles included Past President of Albany Civitan Club; Past President, Rotary Club of Dougherty County; and President Georgia Association of Broadcasters. He served with various other community organizations including American Red Cross and as a Trustee of Darton College. He was a former member of Doublegate Country Club and Stonebridge Golf and Country Club where he pursued his passionate love of golf. He was also a proud Army Veteran.
