Ruby Helen Green Hambrick, 91, of Albany died Thursday, June 25, 2015 at her home.

Her funeral service will be held Monday, 11AM June 29, 2015, at First Baptist Church of Albany with internment following at Crown Hill Cemetery. Reverend Bruce English and Dr. Ron Holman will be officiating.

Mrs. Hambrick was born July 19, 1923, in Albany, GA daughter of Ruby Rebecca Green and William Walter Green, Sr. She graduated from Albany High School in 1940.

Mrs. Hambrick loved her Lord, her family and her community. At the time of her death, Mrs. Hambrick was the oldest living member of First Baptist Church, having been enrolled in the Cradle Roll in 1923. Very active in service, she taught GA's, Acteens, Youth and 4 and 5 year olds. She also took part in WMU Missions.

Mrs. Hambrick had volunteered at Phoebe Putney Hospital for 15 years. She was preceded in death by her daughter, Lynda Hambrick Martin Gray, and her husband of 70 years Taplin Burton Hambrick.
