Russell Dale Ober, 63 of Leesburg, GA, died Friday, November 18, 2011 at Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital. The memorial service will be held Monday, November 21, 2011 at 2:00PM at Kimbrell-Stern with visitation preceding the service at 1:00. Pastors Bill Diamond and Charles Thompson will officiate.
