Ruth Anderson, a long time resident of Albany passed away early Sunday Morning at Morningside Assisted Living. Mrs. Anderson was born in Maulden, MA on October 4, 1923. She worked for General Electric in Boston during World War II in support of the war effort. She moved to Hollywood Beach, FL where she met and married her husband, Paul Anderson, Jr. She and Mr. Anderson reared 8 children. She is preceded in death by her husband Paul M. Anderson Jr. and a son Robert G. Anderson. Survivors include her son Paul M. Anderson III and his wife Karen of Albany; son Bruce P. Anderson and his wife Sandy of Tallahassee, FL; daughter Celeste Anderson Rustin and her husband Neil of Leslie, GA; son Greg Anderson of Albany, GA; daughter Laura Anderson Richardson and her husband Mark of Dahlonoga, GA; son John Anderson Sr. of Panama City Beach, FL; and daughter Nancy Anderson Shear and her husband David of Winter Spring, FL. She is also survived by 16 grandchildren, 16 great grandchildren, and 2 great-great grandchildren. Mrs. Anderson was a faithful parishioner of St. Teresa's Catholic Church and between her children and grandchildren they attended the Catholic School for more than 40 continuous years. She was a member and former president of the Council of Catholic Women; a long-time member of the Dawson Road Garden Club; and was a charter member of the Albany Chapter of Women In Construction. She and her husband founded Anderson Roofing Company, Inc. where she served as Secretary Treasurer for more than 40 years. She was a wonderful mother, wife, sister, and beloved friend.
