Ruth Young (Mrs. James M.) Robinson, 98, of Albany died Wednesday January 14, 2015.

Funeral services will be conducted Friday (Today) 11:00 AM at Crown Hill Cemetery. The Rev. Ann Heinemann officiating. The family will receive friends following the service at the cemetery.

Mrs. Robinson was a long time resident of Albany. She was employed by Southern Bell Telephone prior to her marriage. She conducted town hall meeting throughout Southwest Georgia in the mid-1930s teaching local residents to use the new dial telephones. She was member of St. Paul's Episcopal Church.

She was preceded in death by her husband, James M. Robinson, her parents, Elzie Thomas Young and Bertha Beasley Young Lamerton, and three brothers: Ben Young, Gene Young and Thomas Young.
