A native of Atlanta, GA Mr. Harris attended school in East Point, GA and graduated from Russell High School in 1945, where he was active in all sports and was a member of football team that won the NGIC football championship in 1944. Mr. Harris attended Atlanta Division of the University of Georgia and Georgia State College and graduated from Atlanta Law School. He was a veteran of the United States Marine Corps having served in WW II. Mr. Harris worked for Southern Railroad in the Traffic Department and worked for 41 years before retiring as District Sales Manager in Albany in 1987. He was active in the Albany Community serving on the Board of Directors with the Albany Chamber of Commerce and served as chairman of the Military Affairs Committee and the Transportation Committee. Mr. Harris was on the Board of Directors with the United Way and was chairman on several committees. He was a member of the First Baptist Church of Albany and served on the Board of Deacons.
