Sammy L. Dix, 84, of Albany, died Monday, September 5, 2005 in Atlanta, GA. A native of Ocilla, GA, he had lived in Albany since 1950. Mr. Dix was a member and Deacon of Byne Memorial Baptist Church. He also taught the Men's Sunday School Class at Byne. Mr. Dix was a Navy veteran of World War II, serving on the battleship USS Missouri. He was employed for 44 years with Equifax as an insurance investigator. Mr. Dix served as President of the Eighth Ave. Little League Ballpark for many years. Following his retirement, Mr. Dix was an avid golfer. He was preceded in death by his wife of 58 years, Julia Luckie Dix. Mr. Dix's survivors include his 2 sons: Steve Dix, Albany, Scott Dix, Athens, GA; 2 grandchildren: Samantha Dix and Tim Dix, both of Albany; a brother: Bobby Dix, Ocilla; a sister: Frances Wynn, Ocilla.
