She traveled for Sunshine Tours as escorts along with husband for 8 1/2 years. Mrs. King was a charter member of Porterfield Memorial United Methodist Church and has been the Sunday School Teacher for the Fellowship Class. She was a Bible Study leader for Methodist Women for many years. Mrs. King was President of Women Society and has worked (volunteered) for the gift shop at Phoebe ever since it opened. She was a member of XYZ and did meals on wheels for many years.
