



## Mrs. Sarah Alice Holland

November 14, 1941 - March 15, 2026

A visitation for Sarah Alice Holland will be held at Crown Hill Chapel at 9:00 a.m. on Friday, March 20, 2026, with a funeral service to follow at 10:00 a.m. She will be laid to rest at the Crown Hill Mausoleum on Dawson Road in Albany, Georgia. Ms. Holland died on Saturday, March 14, 2026, at Oaks Senior Living in Leesburg, Georgia.

Born November 14, 1941, in Ozark, Alabama, Ms. Holland was known for her strong faith, love of teaching, and passion for writing. She was a retired educator with 31 years of service, having worked at St. Teresa's School, the Georgia State Department of Education, and the Dougherty County School System, though her love for teaching began long before her professional career.

Beginning at age eleven, Ms. Holland taught nursery and later early elementary-aged children at Sale City Baptist Church and helped organize and teach Vacation Bible School through high school until leaving for college. Over the years, she remained active in her church communities, teaching children's and adult Sunday school, Bible school, and day school, and sang in the choirs at First Baptist Albany and Sale City Baptist.

For several years, Ms. Holland entertained residents of assisted living homes with gospel and country-western karaoke as well as made wheelchair bags for the residents.

In 2006, Ms. Holland published *Turpentine Stills, Sawmills, and Cotton: A History of*

Sale City, Georgia 1901–2006, which can be found in libraries across the United States.

Ms. Holland is survived by her three children, Joanne Holland Campbell (David Campbell), Bobby Holland (Lisa Holland), and Lorraine “Pete” Shiver (Bobby Shiver); three siblings; eight grandchildren; and six great-grandchildren.
