Ms. Sarah Bradley Miller (Sally Bradley) died Tuesday, May 23, 2017 in Charlotte, Michigan after a lengthy illness from a brain aneurysm. A Celebration of Life service will be held on Saturday, June 3, 2017 at 11 a.m. at the Walden Chapel at First United Methodist Church. Rev. Thad Haygood will be officiating, and interment will follow at Crown Hill Cemetery. The family will receive friends for visitation on Friday, June 2, 2017 from 7-8 p.m. at Kimbrell-Stern.
