



## Sarah R. Wetherbee Obituary

January 4, 1916 - March 17, 2009

Sarah Wetherbee, 93, of Albany died Tuesday March 17, 2009 at Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital. Her funeral service will be Friday 11 AM at Crown Hill Cemetery. The Rev. Mark Jones will officiate. The family will receive friends at Mrs. Wetherbee's home 2114 Edgewater Dr., Thursday from 2 PM to 5 PM. Mrs. Wetherbee was born January 4, 1916 in Albany to Dr. James Augustus Redfearn and Elleighfare Muse Redfearn. She graduated from Albany High School and then the University of Georgia in 1936 where she was an Alpha Delta Pi. After graduation, she taught for some years in Butler, Doerun and Brunswick, then worked as a receptionist with her father until she married Bud Wetherbee in 1946. She also worked at the Inner City Authority for the city of Albany. She was a member of the Albany Junior League, the National Society of Colonial Dames of America in the state of Georgia, St. Paul's Episcopal Church, the Sewing Bee and the YMCA. Mrs. Wetherbee was preceded in death by her husband Ernest (Bud) Wetherbee and a son John Pickard Wetherbee. She is survived by her son and daughter in law, Mike and Terri Wetherbee, a daughter Leigh Wetherbee Brooks, four grandchildren: Harriet Wetherbee Ollman and husband Rick, Anne Redfearn Wetherbee, Edward James Wetherbee, and John Whitlock Brooks; sister, Mary Redfearn Kaliher, brother Dr. James Augustus Redfearn, Jr. and wife Agnes as well as numerous nieces and nephews.
