Saundra Kay Clegg, 72, of Albany died Sunday, September 16, 2018 at Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital after a brief illness. Funeral services will be held at Kimbrell-Stern on Thursday, September 20, 2018 at 11:00 a.m.
