Ms. Sheila Barnes Stutsman, 61, of Putney joined our Lord in Heaven on April 2, 2008. A native of Albany, GA, Ms. Stutsman was a 1964 graduate of Albany High School, and attended Valdosta State College. She is a graduate of Georgia Southwestern. She traveled the world as a military wife in the late 1960s and 1970s, before coming back to make Albany her home. She was a dedicated teacher in the Dougherty County School System for over twenty years. She was a lifetime member of VFW Post 2785 Ladies Auxiliary, and a member of American Legion Post #30 Auxiliary. She regularly volunteered, sewing bears for children, with the SOWEGA Knights of Columbus sewing group. She was a dedicated bridge player and an avid coin collector. Other hobbies included reading, watching movies, and listening to the Grateful Dead and Fleetwood Mac. She was a true animal lover, and never turned a stray animal away from her home. Sheila never met a stranger, as every person she encountered could count on a conversation. She was a loving daughter, mother, and sister.
