Spencer Giles, 26, of Albany, died Thursday, June 16, 2005. His funeral service will be SATURDAY 3 PM at Kimbrell-Stern with interment to follow at Crown Hill Cemetery. The Rev. Olin Cain will officiate. A native and lifelong resident of Albany, Spencer attended Deerfield School and graduated from Westover High School in 1996. He was a member of Porterfield Memorial United Methodist Church. Spencer worked at Giles Builders Supply from the age of thirteen until his death.
