



Stanley Milo Trylovich, Sr. Obituary

Stanley Milo Trylovich Sr. 64, of Leesburg died Sunday April 3, 2005 at Florida Hospital in Deland FL. He was on a fishing trip to the St. John's River with his friends. The funeral service will be 3 PM Friday at Kimbrell-Stern Funeral Directors with Rev Chip Greshman and Mr. Sam Dunn officiating. A native of Chicago IL, Mr. Trylovich has lived in the Leesburg area for the past 32 years and was of the Serbian East Orthodox faith.
