Steven James Surface, Sr., 46, of Albany, died Sunday, December 16, 2007 at his residence. The funeral service will be held at 2 PM Wednesday at Liberty Parkway Church of God with Dr. H.W. Rutledge, Jr. officiating. Interment will follow in Riverside Cemetery. A native of Albany, Mr. Surface lived most of his life in Albany. He graduated from Albany High School in 1980. After graduation, Mr. Surface moved to South Carolina where he began working at Golden Coral and quickly became a star manager. It was there that he began his career in the restaurant industry. Mr. Surface moved back to Albany where he opened Austin's and later opened a second location with a partner in Valdosta. He was preceded in death by his maternal grandparents, George and Leila Letchworth; and paternal grandparents, Oliver and Dora Surface. Mr. Surface is survived by two sons, Steven James "Jamie" Surface, Jr. of Americus, and Jonathan Tyler Surface of Albany; his parents, Claude E. and Louise Surface, Sr. of Albany; two brothers, Claude E. Surface, Jr. and his wife Paige of Loganville, and George R.
