Susan J. Thompson, 67, died at her residence at Lake Blackshear, GA, surrounded by her family Thursday, November 27, 2019. Susan started a home business baking and designing cakes that leveraged her artistic creativity. She enjoyed bowling, throwing pottery and dancing. Susan was diagnosed with Multiple Sclerosis which had a big impact on her health but she did not let it define her life. Her humor and love gave her the strength to continue to be a vital part of the lives of her family.
