Sylvia (Sissie) Louise Milton Roseen, 90, of Albany died Wednesday, February 21, 2024. Born in Jacksonville, Florida, Sissie was the Daughter of Sallie and Roland Thomas. She attended Robert E. Lee High School and Jackson Memorial School of Nursing in Miami.

Sissie was part of the volunteer services at Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital for many years. She also served in the Charity League and was President in 1991. Sissie was a long time member of the Elk's Lodge and became the first female exalted ruler in 2011. She was a long time member of the Covenant Presbyterian Church. Sissie loved to dance and spent time between the Elk's, Moose and V.F.W. when they had bands playing; and she enjoyed spending time with her Ya Ya's.

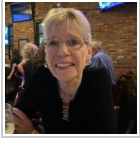
