Raymond "Tater" Hasty, 48 of Albany died Friday, February 3, 2017 at Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital.

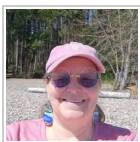

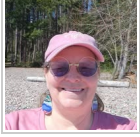
