



## Mr. Terrell Parks Creech Obituary

August 30, 1928 - December 18, 2013

Terrell Parks Creech, 85, of Norcross GA (formerly of Albany) died Wednesday, December 18, 2013 at Peachtree Christian Hospice in Duluth GA. His graveside memorial service will be held at 4 PM on Saturday, December 21, 2013 at Crown Hill Cemetery (Dawson Road), Albany GA. The Rev. Dr. William (Biff) Coker of Covenant Presbyterian Church will officiate.

Mr. Creech was born in Metter GA (Candler County) in 1928 and later his family moved to Macon.
