Theresa M. Levesque, 70, died, Saturday, October 31, 2015, at Phoebe Worth Medical Center in Sylvester, GA. A funeral mass will be held in memory of Ms. Levesque at 11 AM on Thursday, November 5, 2015 at St. Theresa's Catholic Church in Albany; Father Ray Levreault will be officiating. Burial will take place after the service at Floral Memory Gardens in Albany, GA.

Theresa was born in Oran, Algeria November 2, 1944. She spent the younger years of her life in Albany, GA, later moving to Woonsocket, RI. Theresa lived in Woonsocket, Rhode Island for 37 years; she worked for St. Theresa's Catholic Church in Nasonville, Rhode Island. Theresa worked as the Religious Educator and Coordinator for the church; she was also a member of the choir at St. Theresa's. While in Rhode Island, Theresa helped found The Little Flower Home for abused women. Theresa was also a member of St. Theresa's Catholic Church in Albany, GA. She was a loving mother to her children and grandchildren and a loving care giver for her parents and sister Lulu.

She is survived by her sons, Joseph and Jeffery Plante; her sisters, Julie Stanteiski and Lulu Johnson; her brother, Buddy Johnson (Arlene); her grandchildren, Amanda Plante, Kayla Plante, Ryan Plante, Chelsea Plante and Alexandra Plante, her great-grand daughter; Lana Taychack. She also loved her many nieces and nephews very much.

Ms. Levesque was preceded in death by her parents, Albert Eugene Johnson Jr. and Marie Nieves Carrasco, and her son, John Plante.

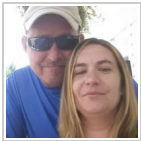
