



## Mrs. Theresa Hutchings Webb

Theresa Hutchings Webb, 84, beloved mother, grandmother and friend, died Saturday, April 16, at her residence. Funeral services will be held Tuesday, April 19, 2016, at 11:00 a.m. at Porterfield United Memorial Methodist Church. The Rev. Leigh Ann Raynor will officiate.
