Thomas Richard Katchmar was born on October 19th, 1947 in Baltimore, Maryland and passed away August 7th, 2016. He was 68 years old. His wife, son, and grand-daughter were by his side when he passed. Memorial services will be held Friday, August 12, 2016 at 4:00 PM at Kimbrell-Stern. Rev. Steve Hurley will officiate.

Tom served in the United States Air Force as a Military Policeman from August 1966 through April 1970. He did 1 tour in Vietnam March 1968 – March 1969

Tom was an Albany Police Officer for 26 years, retiring as a Captain in 1996. U.S. Marshal's Service – 19 years of service after his retirement from the Albany Police Department.

Tom was a loving, caring person, devoted to his family and friends. On the outside he was one tough customer, but on the inside was a softie when it came to his family and his cats. Tom was an avid sports fan. His team, the Atlanta Braves, was his all-time favorite win or lose. Any sport that involved a ball had his full attention year-round, except maybe golf. Tom had very few prized possessions, but one was his car. In 1970, Tom bought a Ford Mustang. It's been restored twice, and will be at his Memorial Service. He loved that car, and anyone who knew him, knew about that car.

Tom truly loved policing and was so proud of the men and women he worked with and their service to the city of Albany.

After he retired from APD, Tom worked for the U.S. Marshal Service. He worked with so many friends from APD and loved being able to still do his job among those friends. It kept him young.

You could do no better than Tom Katchmar as a friend. He was always there for anyone who needed him, without question. His sudden passing will be hard to get through, and he will be sorely missed by all who had the pleasure of knowing him.
